A Bit Of Truth

Meet Jackie, this is her first visit to the Spiritual Fruit Farm. She is 13 years old and lives at the Water Street Rescue Mission with her Mom, sister and brothers. Jackie is learning that a horse is a big pile of flesh that could become very dangerous if it is not in control. You can see the sheer size of the horse (7' 10") compared to the 6" bit that controls it.

In the same way, Jackie is learning that the book of James tells us that if anyone does not stumble on what he says he is a perfect man able to bridle the whole body and we put bits into the mouths of horses so that they might obey us as we direct their entire body as well. So the tongue is the small part of the body, and yet it boasts of great things. With it we bless our Lord and our Father, and with it we curse men who have been made in the image of God. James points these things ought not to be this way.



Verbal abuse is a learned behavior passed down generationally and just as a horse needs to be broken so it is with the generational cycle of verbal abuse. In today's environment, our children are continually learning to masterfully hurl verbal attacks towards their relatives, friends and teachers. The power of words lies in the degree of respect, authority, adoration and value their victim assigns to the perpetrator. Proverbs 18:21 tells us, "Life and death are in the power of the tongue", and the most destructive impact of verbal abuse comes from the fact that the words contain a hint of truth. We see this manifestation of verbal abuse in the abrasive work environment as well as tearing down marriages. If the chain of verbal abuse is to be broken then the tongue must be bridled.

If life and death are in the power of the tongue, like the Proverb says, if this is true, then we need to let Jesus reign in our hearts and help us understand that our words have life long consequences to those who cross our paths and lie in our wake.

SPIRITUAL FRUIT FARM at CREATION 2003!


